Ask

How can we hear God?

Read

Hebrews 1:1-2, 4:12-13 (CEV)

*MEMORY VERSE: Hebrews 1:2

Say

The Bible says that God can speak to us in many different ways. In this memory verse we learn that God wants us to listen to Jesus. We can listen to Jesus when we read, pray and think about what Jesus has said.

Jesus said it like this, "I am the good Shepherd, I know my sheep, and they know me ... the sheep know my voice, and I will call and lead them" John 10:1-5.

Question

Who do the sheep in the story represent?

What do the sheep need to do in order to find life? (John 10:10) Listen to the Shepherd - Jesus!

Have you heard Jesus speak to you before? (Share a personal story here to help guide the discussion).

Activity

Practice listening to Jesus, by doing a listening prayer!

- Start by having the children sit in silence for 30 seconds.
- Then read John 10:7-10 slowly as the children have their eyes closed.
- Ask, was there a word or phrase that stood out to you?
- Pray and thank God that He speaks to us through His Word!

Game (Optional)

Play "Who's That?"

- Have children close their eyes, and pick someone to say "hello" (the trick - they must disguise their voice).
- Have a child guess who they think it is
