Say

Our actions have consequences. The Bible talks about how everyone has sinned. Sin is anything we think, say or do that goes against what God wants us to think say, or do.

Do you remember what the consequence of sin is? Death. Jesus wants to give us life, both now, but also forever with Him. So that is why Jesus died.

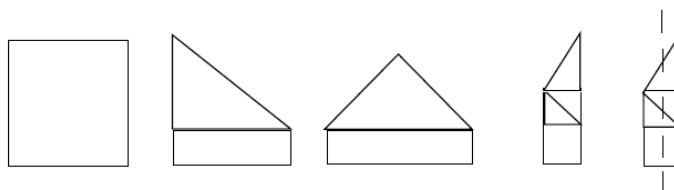
