Ask

Why can't we see God?

Read

John 4:23-24

Say

The Bible tells us that God is Spirit. This means that God does not have a physical body and He can't be seen. Now because God cannot be seen we are reminded to worship Him in spirit and in truth. This means that as we believe and put our trust in Jesus (who is the Truth), we receive the gift of God's Spirit. Therefore, even though we can't physically see God, God Spirit comes into our life so that we can feel and experience His love!

Question

Have you ever felt God's love? *Share a personal story here if you have one.*

One day when we live with God forever we will see Jesus. Do you have any idea what He will look like? *Read Revelation 1:12-18 (This is how the disciple John described what Jesus looked like).*

Activity

As you read Revelation 1:12-18, have the children draw a picture of Jesus in Heaven.

Game (Optional)

"Blind Obstacle Course"

- Have one child go across the room and put a blindfold on.
- Have another child give directions.
- The objective is to have the child with the blindfold on to successfully get back in their chair without walking into anything.

Key Question - How does this game relate to our relationship with Jesus? (*We can't see God, but we can listen and hear from Him*).
