Ask

Why do we go to Church?

Read

1 Peter 2:9

Say

The Bible shows us that the 'church' is not a building, but rather, the people of God. If you love Jesus you are a part of God's Team. So why do we meet together as God's people? We meet so that we can pray (talk with God together), affirm (encourage one another), read God's Word (the Bible), and then be ready to go tell others about Jesus. This is our PART on God's Team: P-pray, A-affirm, R-read, T-tell.

Question

According to 1 Peter 2:9 what do we become when we join Jesus' Team (the church)? *Royal (prince and princesses), Priests (able to speak and listen to God), Holy (set apart), God's special possessions (loved and cherished by God).*

What is your favorite thing about meeting as the church (God's Team)?

Activity

Encouragement circle! Based on the 'a' in our PART on God's Team, spend time having everyone going around affirming/encouraging one another.

This can be done through words, or children can write cards/notes for each other. *If you are the teacher, start by encouraging each of your kids.*

Game (Optional)

"Priest, Royal, Holy"

- Say a title and kids must do the action. Go faster and faster.
- Priest action - kneeling with hands together praying.
- Royal action - sitting down with your hands on the side of your head like a crown.
- Holy action - standing with hands raised up.
