 5. Craft/Activity
 6. Experiential game
 7. Prayer/Application
- 4) _____
 - How can you take the central message and bring it to life?
 - Kids can act out the story, re-tell the story back to you
 - You can use object lessons or share a personal story
- 5) _____
 - Pray for the children by name throughout the week
 - Pray for the Holy Spirit to speak through you to the children
 - Be excited to be there! Find ways to incorporate fun (music, decorations, etc.)
